


Rules on letting this property

Properties can be let if they have an energy rating from A+ to E.

Energy rating and score

This property's current energy rating is E.



Properties get a rating from A+ (best) to G (worst) and a score.

The better the rating and score, the lower your property's carbon emissions are likely to be.
