### Planned to help your business take off

Aero Centre Yorkshire - Doncaster Sheffield Airport, is one of the most exciting developments in the South Yorkshire region, giving businesses who choose to base themselves at the site unrivalled access to the UK's newest Airport.

The Airport opened for its first commercial flight in April 2005 and now handles more than 700,000 passengers a year. Operators include Thomson, First Choice, Wizzair, Aer Lingus, Thomas Cook and Flybe, serving 40 destinations across Europe, the USA and Canada. The 2,893m runway is also capable of handling the largest commercial freighter aircraft including the Boeing 747 and the Antonov 124.

The Airport estate extends to approaching 800 acres with planning consent for over 1.25 million sq ft of commercial development, offering occupiers an ideal location for an office HQ building, office developments and high-tech manufacturing or distribution warehouse units.

Occupiers include Europear, ABP Connect, Cargo Handling Centre, Redline Aviation Security and the UK's only Cessna Citation Service Centre. It is also home to Vulcan to the Sky Trust, who own and maintain one of the few remaining Vulcan Bombers. The Vulcan Aviation Academy will open soon.

Amenities on-site include a 100 bed Ramada Encore hotel, a children's nursery, a school, health and fitness facilities and a number of retail outlets within the terminal building.

Peel Logistics can deliver design and build opportunities of up to 250,000 sq ft at Aero Centre Yorkshire for manufacturing and distribution warehousing whilst Peel Land and Property can deliver office facilities on a design and build basis up to 30,000 sq ft. ### A young and well-skilled workforce

The Sheffield City Region has a young and dynamic workforce. The working population is approximately 906,000.

It has a strong skills base in manufacturing, IT, creative and cultural industries, aviation, engineering and logistics. This is a result of the area being a national logistics hot spot; its location between the Humber ports and the motorway network makes it an ideal distribution location for national and international distribution.

# Enterprise zone status

What benefits does the Aero Centre Yorkshire Enterprise Zone status offer for businesses?

Aero Centre Yorkshire lies within the Sheffield City Region Enterprise Zone, which is one of only six Enterprise Zones in England that are able to offer Enhanced Capital Allowances, giving 100% tax relief to businesses making large investments in plant and machinery.

100% first-year allowances (FYAs) will be available for significant investments in plant or machinery made up until March 2020. These generous allowances make investment in major equipment more affordable and viable for businesses setting up or expanding in the region's manufacturing centres of excellence.

#### Example

A company spending £50 million on qualifying plant and machinery would benefit from a corporation tax reduction in year one of £10.5 million (£50 million x 100% ECA x 21% corporation tax rate), compared to reduction of £1.89 million (£50 million x 18% normal capital allowance x 21% corporation tax rate) for a company locating outside the Enterprise Zone.



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M18 J3 Link Road brings Aero Centre Yorkshire closer





The M18 J3 Link Road is a new £56 million, three mile long link road that will connect Aero Centre Yorkshire directly to the M18 at junction 3. The opening of the new link road will be transformational for Aero Centre Yorkshire as a major logistics hub. Construction began in October 2013.

Aero Centre Yorkshire is located within 20 minutes of five major motorways – the M1, M18, M180, M62 and A1(M). M18 J3 Link Road reduces journey times even further and allow for easy access to the UK's North/ South and East/West arterial routes. In fact, it will bring Aero Centre Yorkshire within a two hour drive of 50% of the UK's manufacturing base.

The Business Park is also connected to the East Coast Main Line at Doncaster via a regular airport shuttle bus, providing connections to most of the UK's major cities.



Superbly located for the national motorway networks and global freight transportation, Aero Centre Yorkshire offers high quality industrial/distribution buildings up to 250,000 sq ft (23,226 sq m).

Typical specification will include:

- Minimum 7m eaves height
- Fully-fitted offices
- Floor loading from 35kN/sq m
- 3 phase power supply
- Self-contained and secure service yards
- Ground and/or dock level loading
- Generous car parking areas
- High-quality landscaped environment.



# Build-to-suit industrial/distribution buildings up to 250,000 sq ft at one of the UK's most important logistics locations

Aero Centre Yorkshire sits at a central hub in the UK's motorway network. With the new link road route linking the park directly to junction 3 of the M18 now open, occupiers will benefit from direct access to the M18, M1 and A1(M) North-South motorways, and the M62 and M180 East-West motorways.

These connections offer significant advantages to logistics businesses based at Aero Centre Yorkshire:

- Return journeys to all major UK-mainland markets within one HGV driver shift\*
- Same-day deliveries to major markets in both southern England and central Scotland\*

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Easy access and outstanding amenities make Aero Centre Yorkshire a perfect place to work

Aero Centre Yorkshire benefits from a number of on-site amenities including a 100 bed Ramada Encore hotel, a children's nursery and health and fitness facilities.









The site is within 20 minutes of five motorways; the M1, M18, M180, M62 and A1(M) and road links have improved further with the completion of the new M18 J3 Link Road route. This will bring 1.1 million people within a 30 minute drive to work time.

Doncaster town centre is less than 20 minutes drive from Aero Centre Yorkshire and Doncaster Transport Interchange operates a regular shuttle bus between the town and airport. The interchange is located on the East Coast Main Line which connects London to Edinburgh. There are regular trains between Doncaster and London with the fastest journey time being just 96 minutes.





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With a huge volume of operational space, lots of warehousing capacity and the second longest runway in the North of England, Aero Centre Yorkshire (ACY) Cargo can transport goods quickly and safely to anywhere in the world.

The combination of convenience and first class service saw the amount of cargo transported by ACY through 2013 and 2014 increase by 112%. This growth represents continued evidence that the airport's cargo terminal is enhancing its reputation around the world.

ACY is on the doorstep of huge manufacturing economy. As well as being home to some of the biggest logistics operations in the country, 68% of Sheffield City Region SMEs are now actively exporting – one of the highest rates in the North of England.

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

### M18 J3 Link Road: The road to the future

Since the M18 J3 Link Road opened it has halved journey times between Aero Centre Yorkshire and junction 3 of the M18, dramatically improving the Park's connectivity and unlocking its true potential as one of the regions most important advanced logistics hubs.

This direct access to the national motorway network doubles the number of people living within half an hour (drive to work time) to 1.1million and provides superfast access to Doncaster International Railport. This will provide occupiers with an unrivalled package of air, road, rail and sea links, effectively making the Park a multi-modal location.

Doncaster is already the location of choice for many major companies including IKEA, BMW, Amazon and B&Q. M18 J3 Link Road ensures it becomes even more attractive to the country's leading retailers and logistics companies.











